

Animals:

8:30 Supervise cleaning, feeding and handling of animals. Children must wash their hands before and after handling animals.

10:20 Put animals away, wash your hands, get snack mats and bookbag and from upper yard shed area, set up and **be available to greet children.**

10:30 Facilitate a snack group in upper yard

11:00 Resume supervision of animals or other upper/lower yard activities.

11:30 Clean up: make sure animals are taken care of. Lock animal area. Refill paper towel and soap dispensers throughout the school. Use Liquid Softsoap and dilute with water. Check yard for materials left out. Lower umbrella and tie closed. Help with artwork/woodwork to go home.

11:45 Adults join meeting time, supporting children, Participate! Sing! Do not let children or adults disrupt the group.

12:05-12:30 Parent Staff meeting in Quiet area
